

Supporting Skilled Trades and Technical Training in Saskatchewan

Program Overview

Professional Building Inspections, Inc. (PBI) is proud to support the development of skilled trades and technical professionals across Saskatchewan. The **PBI Trades & Training Scholarship Program** assists residents of municipalities served by PBI pursuing post-secondary or trades-related education.

We recognize the essential role that tradespeople play in our communities, and we are committed to encouraging the next generation of professionals in building, construction, inspection, and related technical fields.

Scholarship Value

- **\$200 to \$1,000 CAD** per recipient
- Awarded Semi-annually
- Multiple recipients may be selected based on application strength and available funding

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet **all** of the following requirements:

1. **Residency:** Must reside in a Saskatchewan municipality that has officially appointed Professional Building Inspections, Inc. (PBI) and is currently served by them, with at least one permit reviewed by PBI.
2. **Education/Training Path:** Must be enrolled in or accepted to a recognized **post-secondary institution or training program** in a trade or technical field (e.g. carpentry, plumbing, electrical, welding, construction technology, engineering technology, etc.).
3. **Age:** Must be at least 17 years of age at the time of application.
4. **Status:** Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.

Application Requirements

Applicants must submit the following:

1. **Completed Application Form** (available on the PBI website or by request)
2. **Proof of Residency** (e.g. utility bill, driver's license showing an address within a PBI-appointed municipality)
3. **Proof of Enrollment or Acceptance** in a qualifying post-secondary or trade program
4. **Resume** (1–2 pages)
5. **Short Essay (300–500 words):**
 - *Describe your interest in your chosen trade or technical field.*
 - *How will this scholarship support your career goals?*
 - *What does contributing to your local community mean to you?*

Deadline to Apply

- Applications must be received by **December 31st** and **June 30th** annually.

Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by a PBI-appointed committee. Evaluation will be based on:

- Alignment with a trade or technical career path
- Demonstrated community connection
- Clarity of goals and motivation
- Quality of application materials
