BYLAW NO. 1/20

A BYLAW TO PREVENT AND CONTROL CLUBROOT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Sutton No. 103 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "Clubroot Bylaw".

PART I - PURPOSE AND DEFINITIONS

- 2. The purpose of this bylaw is to:
 - a. establish the requirements for clubroot reporting and notification; and
 - b. establish the requirements for clubroot management.
- 3. The Pest Control Act authorizes municipalities and officers to act in relation to clubroot
 - a. Section 4 of *The Pest Control Act* states that "every person shall take measures to destroy, control and prevent the spread of all pests on any land or other premises owned, occupied or controlled by him"
- 4. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Officer" shall mean an officer within the meaning of *The Pest Control Act*, that is to say, a person appointed under section 13 by the council of a municipality or by the minister or a person employed in connection with the administration and management of the department and appointed by the minister for the purpose of enforcing *The Pest Control Act*;
 - b. "Owner" and "Occupant" are as defined in The Municipalities Act;
 - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Sutton No. 103.

PART II - CLUBROOT REPORTING AND NOTIFICATION

- 5. Unless otherwise specified, the owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of land situated in the municipality shall be responsible for carrying out the provisions of this bylaw.
- 6. Every owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any land in the municipality shall notify the municipality in which the land is located of the presence of clubroot within 30 (thirty) days of becoming aware of same.
- 7. Any clubroot survey shall be performed in accordance with the Clubroot Survey Protocol attached as Schedule "A" to this municipality's Policy Regarding the Prevention and Control of Clubroot.
- 8. Notification of the presence of clubroot shall be in writing in Form "A", the Clubroot Survey Form, attached to and forming part of this bylaw. Completed Form "A" should be returned to the office of the Rural Municipality of Sutton No. 103 via email, postal mail, or fax.
- 9. Where the officer believes that a person has contravened any provision of this bylaw, a Bylaw Violation may be served either personally or by mailing or leaving same at the last known address.
- 10. The Bylaw Violation Notice shall be in Form "D" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 11. The Bylaw Violation Notice shall be deemed to have been served:

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- a. on the expiration of 24 hours after it is posted, if the notice is mailed;
- b. on the day of actual delivery, if the notice is served personally; or
- c. on the business day following the transmission, if sent by fax.
- 12. Per subsection 33(1) of *The Pest Control Act*, in lieu of prosecution, the person who has contravened the provisions of this bylaw shall pay a fine in the amount of \$500.00, which shall be indicated on the Bylaw Violation Notice.

PART III - CLUBROOT MANAGEMENT

- 13. Every owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any land where clubroot has been identified through notification within the municipality as per Part II or by any other means shall take measures to manage and prevent the spread of clubroot.
- 14. As required by the officer, the owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any clubroot-infested land shall develop a Clubroot Management Agreement with the assistance of an agrologist currently practicing with the Saskatchewan Institute of Agrologists in accordance with this municipality's Policy Regarding the Prevention and Control of Clubroot.
- 15. The Clubroot Management Agreement shall be in Form "B" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 16. The owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any clubroot-infested land within the municipality shall provide the officer with the Clubroot Management Agreement within 30 business days. The officer will ensure that the Clubroot Management Agreement meets the minimum requirements of *The Saskatchewan Clubroot Management Plan* and will execute the agreement with the owner(s) and/or occupant(s).
- 17. When a formal agreement between the owner(s) and/or occupant(s) and the officer cannot be reached, the officer shall write an order in Form "C", the Clubroot Order, attached to and forming part of this bylaw, as per Section 19 of *The Pest Control Act*.
- 18. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
